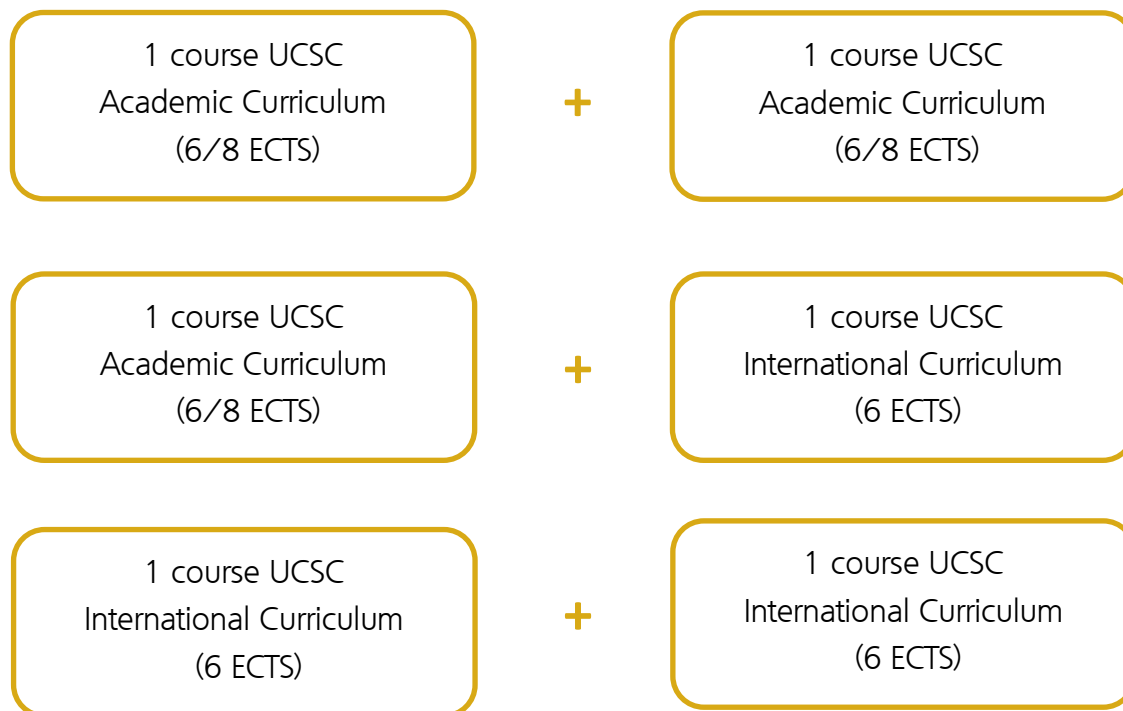




## Program Structure

Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher, or equivalent</li> <li>4. Completion of a minimum of 2 semesters at undergraduate level</li> <li>5. English proficiency: for non-native speaker, applicants need to submit a min. TOEFL score of 79 iBT, an IELTS score of 6 or an equivalent certificate (First Certificate of English - Cambridge ESOL / ISE II - Trinity College, London); or have successfully completed a degree program taught in English; or currently studying in English at their home institution.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants for UCSC coursework in Italian are required to have a good knowledge of the language (B2 level is recommended) and must provide an Italian Language Proficiency Report</li> <li>5.
